Historical Note: This collection is part of the curatorial records section of the Otis Historical Archives. This section and specific collection (OHA 12) relate to the early history of the Army Medical Museum (AMM), now the National Museum of Health and Medicine (NMHM). The AMM was established in 1862, at the beginning of the Civil War, to document battlefield medicine, trauma, and pathology through the collection of records, specimens, and artifacts. The curatorial records document the mission, work, and day-to-day activities of the museum up through the end of World War II, when the museum became a component of the Army Institute of Pathology, later the Armed Forces Institute of Pathology.

**Series/Scope and Content Note**: Records of the museum's participation in the U.S. Centennial International Exhibition (1876), the World's Industrial and Cotton Exposition (1884), and the World's Columbian Exposition (1893).
