"When I Have Your Wounded"—The Transformation of the Army Aeromedical Evacuation in Vietnam

The death of Maj. Charles L. Kelly on July 1, 1964, and his dying words--"When I have your wounded"--have rightfully been seen as a transformative moment in U.S. Army aeromedical evacuation. In this presentation, retired Col. Donald E. Hall, U.S. Army Medical Service Corps, argues that this wasn't an isolated event in Kelly's life, but that his career prepared him for this moment of leadership.
